Cookham Wildlife Supporters starts the new year with a new name - WildCookham. And lots of plans for an increase in activity, calling for support from people across the Cookhams. We have identified a number of ways we shall get involved - a wild garden certification scheme, surveys of local habitats and wildlife, hands on work with our local reserves, the possible recreation of a pond in Cookham Dean.

We're also considering workshops to improve our knowledge and encourage more people to discover more about our local habitats. And we hope to work with local landowners - especially our farmers, National Trust, Woodlands Trust and the John Lewis Partnership - to work towards a sustainable environment for our local flora and fauna.
